

Loreto Grammar School Summer 2020 Appeals Process

Student not happy with result/grade awarded.

Student completes Loreto G.S. Appeals Proforma outlining the grounds for appeal. Form available on School Website. Submit by Friday 21st August 2020.

School reviews internal data which determined the Centre Assessed Grade forwarded to the Examining Board.

School decides whether to uphold the Centre Assessed Grade submitted or to proceed with appeal process on the student's behalf.

SMT meet with student and parent to inform of the outcome of the internal review.

There are grounds for appeal.

Head of Centre submits appeal to Examination Body on behalf of the student by 7th September 2020.

If successful, the final awarded grade may change. If unsuccessful, the final awarded grade may stay the same.

There are no grounds to support the appeal, given internal data.
