

WHAT TO DO if you have been identified as a CLOSE CONTACT of a positive case of Covid-19

PUPILS (P1 – Y14)

Q. Do you have symptoms of Covid 19?

A. No

- You had a **positive PCR test within the last 90 days:**
 - No action is required. Continue to attend school. If new symptoms develop stay at home, book a PCR test straightaway and self-isolate until the results are available.
- You have had **NO previous positive PCR within the last 90 days:**
 - **STAY AT HOME.** Book a PCR immediately. Self-isolate until the result is available. If negative you can return to school. Book another PCR at day 8. If either test is positive you will need to isolate for 10 days from the date of the test.

Q. Do you have symptoms of Covid 19?

A. YES

- **STAY AT HOME. Book a PCR test immediately.** Self-isolate until results are received.
 - **POSITIVE PCR** result? Self-isolate for 10 days from onset of symptoms. **ADVISE SCHOOL** of positive result **ASAP.**
 - **NEGATIVE PCR** result? – see above advice for “no symptom section”.
