As the Minister for Education had agreed that the Summary of Annual Examination Results (SAER) process should be suspended in line with approaches taken in England and Wales, there was no SAER statistical bulletin for the 2019/20 and 2020/21 academic years, which were scheduled to be published in December 2020 and December 2021. School level examination data for 2019/20 and 2020/21 are not being collected for accountability or inspection purposes and no examination data will be released at school level for these two years. It is currently envisaged that a statistical bulletin for the 2021/22 academic year will be published in December 2022.
