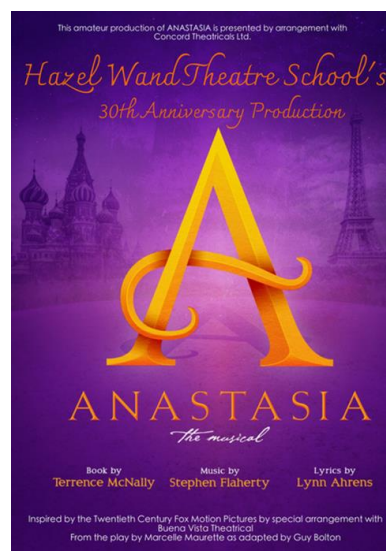


Please note:
